

1. ABOUT THE SOCIETY

St. Louis Grignon de Montfort, the Founder was born on 31st January 1673 in the small town of Montfort in France. Even from his childhood days, he was virtuous and exhibited an extraordinary love for the poor. He loved and admired the mother of Jesus and worked ceaselessly for God and man. He went about from place to place with the message of God's love. He taught poor people and championed their cause. His love for the abandoned and the persons with disability was remarkable.

He died at an early age of 43 years on 28th April 1716. He was proclaimed a Saint in 1946. He established many groups to carry on his good work. One such organization is the Montfort Brothers of St. Gabriel who are making his dreams come true all over India through 200 various apostolates and institutions.

2. OVER VIEW

Montfort School, Guwahati, commenced its educational programmes on 20th January 1996, to impart sound moral, social and physical education, so as to turn out, not only good and useful citizens, but men of high principles, culture and refinement. In the year 2003 the school started imparting education and training to children with disabilities.

Academic year begins in April and ends in March. The medium of instruction is English and the syllabus followed is CBSE. The School is a co-educational institution. It has attached hostels for Boys and Girls.

5. LOCATION

Montfort School is located at a distance of about 18kms from Guwahati railway station and 90kms away from Shillong on G.S. Road.

6. FACILITIES

Laboratory:

'A fully equipped Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Mathematics and Computer Lab for the students to develop practical knowledge functions in the school.

Library:

A well-furnished library with an extensive selection of books, magazines and periodicals to facilitate acquisition of knowledge and to develop reading habit is available in the school.

Multipurpose Auditorium:

A fully outfitted auditorium to demonstrate talents, to conduct assembly and functions is at the disposal of the staffs and students.



Digital Class:

The Digital Class, a multimedia facility has been installed to explore new areas of education and cross-discipline that result when conventional skill collides with the computer age.

7. SPECIAL FEATURES

SEMINARS:

Various seminars and outreach programmes are organized for the students to develop their personality and to motivate them properly. Career guidance is also given at the end of the school year.

FACULTY:

We have well qualified, committed and dedicated teachers to impart holistic education to the students.

COUNSELLING:

Counselling is also given to the students to develop in a healthy manner, to solve and to overcome their daily challenges.

MEDITATION:

Daily meditation is conducted in the morning to realize the presence of God in them and to calm their minds.

HOLISTIC EDUCATION:

Montfort School strives to impart holistic education to the students. To promote and develop the hidden talents of the students through various activities they are divided into 4 houses namely Montfort, Louis, Martin and Gabriel. We also have different clubs to create awareness, instill responsibility and encourage creativity in the students.

8. MONTFORT INCLUSIVE EDUCATION

The school is with a difference and the difference is in our attitude which is positive, enthusiastic and energetic and all encompassing. Our school caters to the educational needs of regular children and also children with disability, especially the Hearing and Visually Impaired children. Vocational training is also imparted to the special children. In short, the students learn to live and grow in an inclusive environment, learning to take care of everyone in the society.

9. ACADEMIC YEAR

The school academic year commences in April and ends in March. The school has two short vacations for Puja & Christmas & a long vacation for summer.

10.ACADEMIC SESSION

The school year is divided into the following terms:
First Term : April to September
Second Term : October to March



11.CURRICULUM

Montfort School offers education from Pre-Primary to Senior Secondary levels.

1. Pre-Primary (LKG & UKG)

English - Reading, writing and conversation.

Hindi - Reading, writing and conversation.

Number work, Health talk, lingual talk, Story telling, Recitation, Rhymes, Physical Education, Art, Singing and Dancing.

2. Primary and Middle School (Std I to Std. VIII)

First Language - English - Reading, Writing, Dictation, Grammar and Composition.

Second Language - Hindi - Reading, Writing, Dictation, Grammar and Composition.

Third Language - Assamese - Reading, Writing, Dictation, Grammar and Composition.

Mathematics - Arithmetic, Basic Elements of Geometry and Practical Skills.

General Science - Introduction to various branches of science and practical work.

Social Science - History, Geography and Civics.

Computer Science – Fundamental Logo, Basics, Windows and MS Office and Programming Languages.

General Knowledge, Moral Science and Religious instruction, Physical Education (Theory and Practice), Art Education, SUPW (Socially Useful Productive Work), Music and Dances, Library, Current Affairs are the other important curricular activities offered.

3. High School (Std. IX to Std. X)

First Language - English - Prose, Poetry, Grammar and Composition.

Second Language - Hindi/Assamese-Prose, Poetry, Grammar and Composition.

Mathematics - Algebra, Geometry, Trigonometry, Statistics and Construction.

Social Science - History, Statistics, Geography and Civics.

General Science - Theory and Practice.

Information Technology- Windows and MS Office and Programming Languages.

Human Rights, Moral Science / Religious instruction, General Knowledge, Art, Drawing and Craft, Music and Dance, Library, Rhetoric, Current Affairs are the other important curricular activities offered.

12. ADMISSION

The right age for admission in LKG is three plus while for admission to class I is five plus. All admissions shall be preceded by certificate verification and an interview. The result will be notified from school office. The decision taken by the school authority in this regard is final. The application form should be filled in with care and submitted along with necessary documents for verification. Incomplete forms will be rejected. Admission is open to all children without discrimination of caste, creed, language, or disability.

13. WITHDRAWAL

Children are admitted on the understanding that they would remain in the school at least for the entire academic year.

If the parent desires to withdraw the child from the school before the end of the school year, the rules demand the fees for the entire year should be paid before the Transfer Certificate could be issued.

An application for Transfer Certificate should be made in writing by the parent or local guardian.

The management reserves the right to compel the parents to withdraw their children, if their conduct is harmful.

14. UNIFORM

Students should attend school in the prescribed uniform as per the instruction given during admission process.

15. MONTFORT INCLUSIVE HOSTELS FOR GIRLS

Montfort Inclusive Hostel is a Home away from Home, students of different abilities, talents and backgrounds live in love and brotherhood. Great emphasis is given to family spirit, unity, harmony, character formation and all-round development. Family spirit, cheerfulness and friendliness and cooperation are characteristics of Montfort Hostel.

Application for the admission to the hostel can be collected from the school office. Only Montfort school girls are admitted to the hostel. Dismissal or withdrawal from the school would mean dismissal and withdrawal from the hostel as well.

The warden will be in charge of the management and day to day administration of the hostel.

In matters of admissions, accommodation and disciplinary action the Director's/Principal's ruling is final. The hostel fee to be paid for 12 months.

DISCIPLINE

Every boarder shall maintain the highest moral standards of life at all places. All cases of illness must be immediately reported to the wardens. In case of serious illness the parent/guardian must pay the total fees due for the year.

An inmate who wishes to vacate the hostel must give a written notice two weeks in advance signed by the parent/guardian and total fees due for the year will have to be paid.

VISITORS AND PHONE

- Relatives and friends of students are not allowed to visit boarders during school hours.
- Parents are requested not to disturb the regular rhythm of the boarding by their frequent visits and phone calls.
- If there is an urgent need to call your children you may do so only on Sundays between 12.30 p.m. to 2 p.m.
- Parents / Guardians are allowed to visit the children only in the afternoon on second Saturdays and second Sundays with the permission of the warden.
- Hostel students are permitted to take leave only for the family programmes related to their father/mother and grandparents- a maximum of 3 days other than holidays.
- Those students who go home for holidays are to be back by the eve of the next working day before 5pm.

16. OTHER FACILITIES IN THE CAMPUS

Early identification Centre (EIC): To detect the hearing loss of infants /children at an early stage. We providing guidance and counselling to the parents and children.

NIOS: Our school is an accredited Institution under NIOS for class X for dropouts and others.

Social Concerns: We have two literacy centers to educate children who do not attend any school to make them literate.

Clubs: We have different clubs in the school for varied activities. All the students from class V to XII are members of one club or another. They have varied activities to develop themselves and to contribute their might for social transformation.

ATL (Atal Tinkering Lab): Atal Tinkering Laboratory under Atal Innovative Mission of NITI, Aayog, Government of India is setup.

Physiotherapy Unit: Physiotherapy unit is set up in 2017 and caters service to the differently abled students and the people in need.

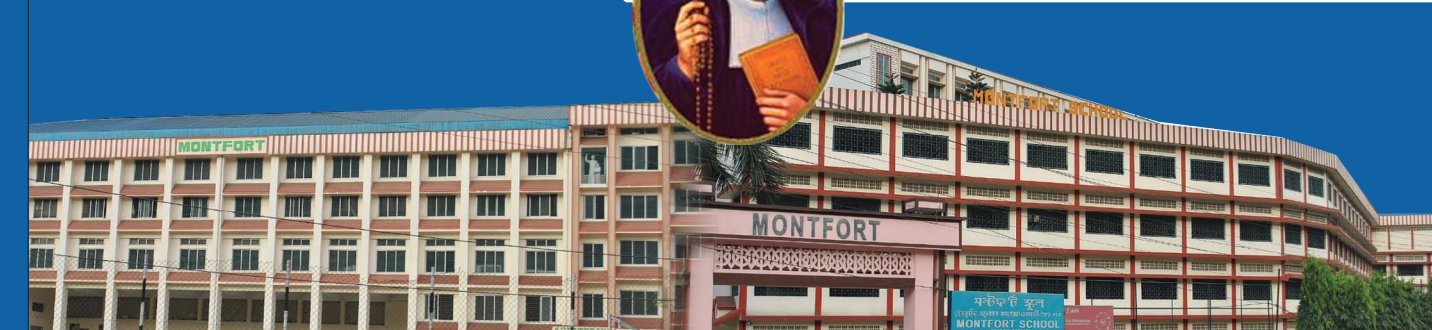
